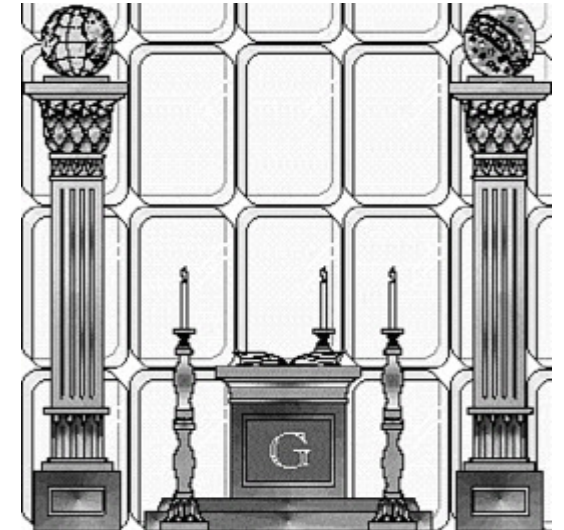

FROM THE EAST

Brethren,

Brothers by your vote the amendment concerning the bylaws was approved by a unanimous vote. This bylaw change was crucial for the financial future of our Lodge. So many lodges are closing their doors due to lack of funds. There has been a running misconception as to our membership base and Lodge income. We do have a membership of approx. 600 members. However excluding the emeritus, exempt and perpetual members, there are 479 actual dues paying members.

Also this past month, a resolution was signed by myself and our lodge secretary to reinstate the Sarasota DeMolay Chapter. DeMolay is a Masonic-sponsored youth organization for boys ages 12–21. A young man does not need to have a family tie or sponsor in a Masonic organization to join DeMolay. DeMolay youth petitions are available in the Lodge. Brethren please consider a young man to join our Masonic youth organization.

At the Annual Ritual Competition our neighboring lodge Manatee #31 competed representing the 27th Masonic district and Zone 8. Members of Sarasota Lodge were on hand to show support and share in Masonic fellowship. It should be noted Manatee Lodge scored a total of 945 pts – resulting in 4th place. The first place team scored 990 pts. What an impressive sight to see near flawless degree work with brothers represented from the entire state.

Reports of the 181st Annual Grand Communication and the resulting legislature were reported on the 8th of last month. For those members with a registered Masonic Digest, resulting page updates should be forth coming. The Legislation results were consistent to how the Lodge voted for its delegates to ballot at the Grand Communication.

At our first stated communication, July 13th, we will have the honor of receiving our own newly installed Right Worshipful District Deputy Grand Master - Frank S. Albinson.

Brothers please join us in receiving him on his official visitation to his home Masonic Lodge of Sarasota #147.
