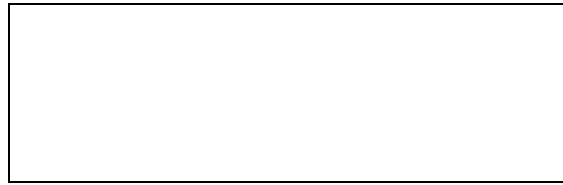

The House of the Temple in Washington D.C. has been deluged with tourists who all seem to voice similar misconceptions about our Rite. James Hodgkins, 32 degree, has prepared the following notes which our brother Masons can use to educate someone who is sincerely curious about our fraternity.

“Did the Scottish Rite originate in Scotland?” No, the Scottish Rite actually came to the U.S. by way of France. There is evidence of “Scotch Masons' Lodges” dating back to 1733 in England. Yet, it was not until 1763 and the creation of the “Order of the Royal Secret” by Stephen Morin of France, that the ritual we practice today began to evolve into a form recognizable to a modern Scottish Rite Mason.
